Adventist Health-Sonora has given us a huge boost...\$4700 to purchase a new 3 door refrigerator. WOW, oh WOW! That will hold much more, enable us to remove the older (less efficient) ones. If you see any management or Marketing Dept folks...thank them heartily. Also Sonora Area Foundation continues to send us generous donations from the community donors. These extra

donations have enabled us to continue to purchase quality foods for our clients. Please be sure to thank Chicken Ranch management, and Clarke Broadcasting for their fundraising HUGE support. Last years cash drive and support from Chicken Ranch and community donors was huge... and we could sustain ourselves for no services interruptions in upgrading our food purchasing, andmore utility assistance for our clients who have been laid off, lost jobs. children home, no day care, etc. Their rents, and utilities continue without a break, and we've been able to increase our assistance, with Salvation Army partnering.

Wood Distribution

Barbara has completed taking wood sign-ups for our clients. Currently she is checking each home for safe storing and burning of the wood we give them. Next she will call each applicant to make an appointment for them to pick up the wood in Nov and Dec. We also refer people to Sierra Bible Church (any age ok) and to the Senior Center (60+ years) for any additional needs The Sonora Sunrise Rotary will deliver wood from the Senior Center to registered clients. So, if you know of anyone who has donated to ours, or the other two programs, as well as anyone in the Sonora Sunrice Rotary Club, please thank them too.
